Opening Tribal Enterprise Hires New Employees

Grand Mound, WA: Talking Cedar Distillery-Brewery-Restaurant is holding a job fair Wednesday, June 10th and Thursday, June 11th, from 10am to 3pm. Talking Cedar is a destination for upscale pub food, craft beer and spirits and we are looking for hard working, motivated self-starters, who desire to be an integral part of a fast-paced work environment. Talking Cedar opens to the public on Tuesday, June 30, 2020.

“The Chehalis Tribe is committed to bringing economic success to the community through new jobs with affordable medical benefits. The pandemic has reminded us that our tribal community is connected to all surrounding counties: Thurston, Lewis, and Grays Harbor. Our community includes our tribal members, but also our neighbors.” said Chris Richardson, Managing Director of Chehalis Tribal Enterprises.

The job fair will take place in the Talking Cedar parking lot, located in front of the new Talking Cedar building at 19770 Sargent Road SW, Grand Mound, WA 98579, next to the Marriott Fairfield Inn & Suites. Positions open to hiring include hosts, servers, bartenders, retail sales, line cooks, prep cooks and dishwashers. You may e-mail your resume to jobs@talkingcedar.com, noting your desired position. However, a resume is not required, so please come to the job fair ready to be hired.

To ensure everyone’s health and safety, the job fair will be held outside in the parking lot, with clearly marked stations under canopy tents. Upon arrival, go to the first station marked “Check-In” to receive further instructions. Bring your own face mask, resume, and pen. Your temperature will be checked upon arrival, so please do not attend if sick. You may have to wait for an interview slot, so observe social distancing or wait in your car, until you are called for your interview. All interviews will follow 6-foot minimum social distancing guidelines. Heritage Distilling hand sanitizer stations will also be available for all. Interviews will take about 15 minutes. Keep your party to a minimum and leave the pet at home too. We do not have access to the hotel which is reserved for guests only during their COVID-19 procedures, so we have port-a-potties on site. Expect to take a UA drug test on site to speed up the hiring process. We are excited to provide competitive opportunities to the community and look forward to seeing all applicants.

Note: We apply a Chehalis Tribal Member and Native American preference policy to all employment applications.
